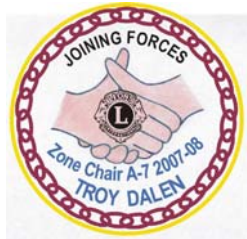

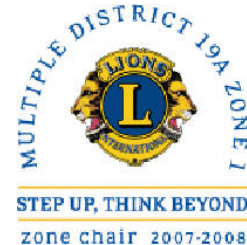

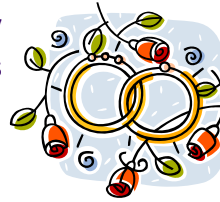

of their beloved daughter Tarsha after 7 months of coma from a car accident in Spain. ZC Ellie has attended the memorial service to show support to the family.

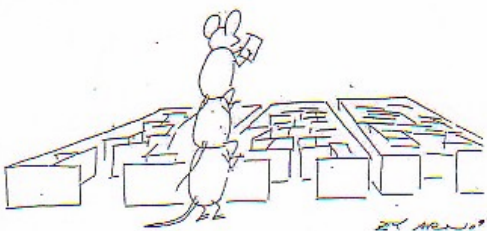
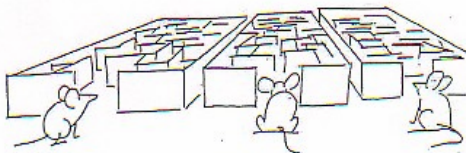

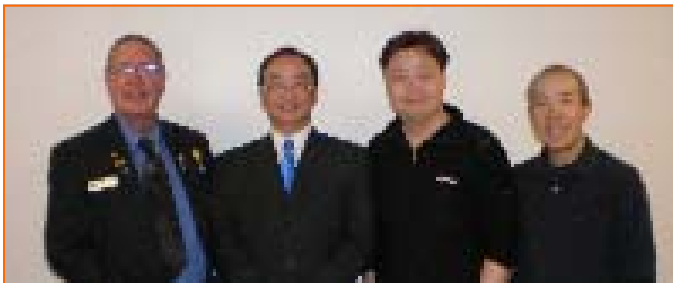


NEWS FROM LCI

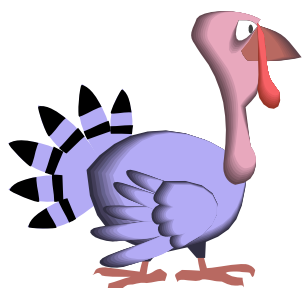

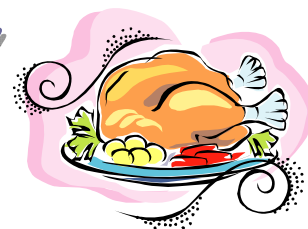
