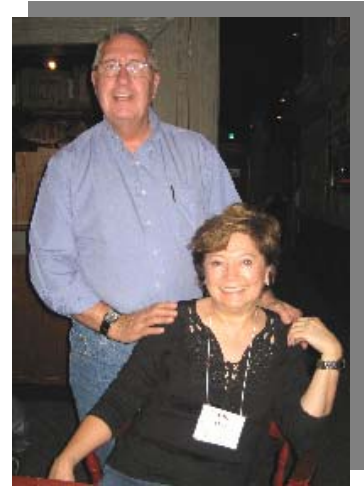
Share ideas and help in club fundraisers and activities. Involve your families, and keep your members interested.

Presidents and Secretaries, please make use of this by letting us know a week in advance what you want to high-light on the Overhead.

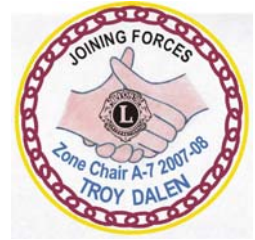
A brief tail-twisting game brings laughter and fellowship in among all the Club reporting businesses.
